Frequently asked Questions for the Spokane International After School Program

1. If my student does not attend Spokane International Academy, are they allowed to participate?

a. No. This program is designated for students who attend Spokane International Academy.

2. Are scholarships available for this program?

a. Yes. You will have to apply for a scholarship through our website; if the scholarship is granted, it will last the rest of the calendar year. You can find more info [HERE](#).

3. Where will the location of the program be?

a. All sessions will take place on the campus of SIA.

4. Are home schooled students that attend Spokane International Academy, allowed in this program?

a. Yes. If you have a homeschooled student that is located in the district, they are encouraged to join. Parents will be responsible for all transportation, to and from the school.

5. Do coaches need experience, and how much are they paid?

a. Experience in coaching, whether in the specific sport or not, is great but not required. SYSA offers a full curriculum for each age group and each day of the camp. The curriculum has resources so that any person can coach the program, whether they have experience or not. Coaches are paid \$25/hour.

6. What requirements do you need to meet to be a coach?

a. Coaches must be 14 years of age, be able to pass a background check, and be able to complete the SYSA Abuse Prevention training to be a coach. Experience in coaching is great, but not required.

7. What is the difference between SYSA sports programs and the Spokane International Academy After School Program?

a. SYSA is not an after school program and is offered to anyone in the greater Spokane area.

i. Example: A first grader will participate in 6 practices and 6 games and receive a uniform and socks for \$85.

b. The SIA After School Program is an after school program that is only for students who attend SIA. This program allows for students to work on individual skill development.

i. Example: A first grader will participate in 5 soccer training sessions, after school, for \$50.
